




Parking and Access (Day Permit Holders).

There is a public parking area alongside the road and near the gate to the reservoir. These parking areas are not controlled by Llanelli Angling Association and parking here is at your own risk.

Access to the reservoir is via the kiss gate as shown on map.

Alternatively there is an option to join the association as a member for an annual fee (£20 for 2016) and you can enjoy the same access and parking as season ticket holders. Plus the use of the boats (terms and conditions apply). For more info go to www.llanelliangling.org.uk

From Carmarthen

Take the A484 towards Llanelli at Cwmffrwd take the slight left onto the B4309 sign posted Pontyates. Continue on the B4309 for 9 miles through Pontyates to the village of Five Roads.

Continue on the B4309 through Five Roads towards Llanelli for 1 mile then turn left onto unclassified road.

Follow road for 0.9 miles turn left and follow this road for 0.2 miles and you will see the entrance gate to the reservoir on the left, with two parking areas on either side of the road.

From Cross Hands.

Take the A476 towards Llanelli. Continue on the A476 through Upper Tumble and the village of Llannon towards Llanelli for 6.6 miles and take the first right after you pass the Swiss Valley Garden Centre onto unclassified road.

Follow this road for 1 mile and you will see the entrance gate to the reservoir on the right, with two parking areas on either side of the road.

From M4 junction 48.

Take the A4138 towards Llanelli. Continue on the A4138 through two roundabouts following signs for Llanelli.

At third roundabout take 3rd exit sign posted Felinfoel B4303 (A476) Continue for 1.1 miles, when at T junction turn right onto A476.

Follow A476 for 0.9 miles and turn left immediately after yellow sign reading 195 casualties 2004-2009 Follow this road for 1 mile and you will see the entrance gate to the reservoir on the right, with two parking areas on either side of the road.
